Each week of camp we will have a special guest speaker and field trips. Individual weekly flyers will be sent home so that you will know what your child needs to bring for the week.

Creative Kids will provide breakfast and an afternoon snack each day. Lunch will not be included, and you will have to pack a lunch for your child each day. All activity fees, transportation fees, and field trips are included in tuition.

All children will be expected to exhibit age appropriate behavior, or they will not be allowed to return the following day! We adhere to our behavior policy even during the summer program and expect students to be safe, kind and helpful.

#### Week #1 Welcome to Summer Camp! -7/01/19 - 7/05/19 (Closed 7/4/19)

Guest Speaker, Seattle Parks, Seattle Storm game, and Bike Rodeo! These are all activities we have planned to kick off the first week of Camp. Creating a sense of unity and team building activities will be our main goal for our first week of camp to make the rest of our summer one to remember!

#### Week #2 Natural Wonders- 7/08/19 - 7/12/19

We will start our week with a wild life research project, using investigative skills, tools and technology to prepare for a trip to the Woodland Park Zoo. We will create our own natural pigments from plants, make maps of the Seattle Parks in the Pacific Northwest, take a visit to Carkeek Park, and spend the day investigating the streams, rivers and beaches!

#### Week #3 Mastering the Arts -7/15/19- 7/19/19

Calling all artisans to the challenge! In just five days- we will create an original masterpiece using different art methods and techniques as well as new mediums. Campers will be given the opportunity to share their creative skills and create a display for an Art Walk. We also look forward to a guest fashion designer, who will teach the kids to create their own pieces. The field trip for this week will be mastering the art of flying and falling, as we make our way to Pump it Up!

#### Week #4 Capturing Stories - 7/22/19 - 7/26/19

Campers will have the opportunity to experience being a photographer this week! Children will be exposed to different photography methods such as film, digital imaging, print making, and layout design. Through the lens of a camera, each camper will be able to experience the beauty of downtown Seattle and Discovery Park.

#### Week #5 Super Soaker! - 7/29/19- 8/02/19

With the sun out more, it is important we remain safe. We will expect a visit from our local Fire Department to talk to everyone about Fire Safety, and also have fun learning with games and trivia! Our daily water filled

moments will include math, science, and fun! Older children will be able to experience the Aquatic Center for some water filled fun, and everyone will look forward to a trip to Camp Long!

#### Week #6 Culinary Chefs 8/05/19 - 8/09/19

Exploring different cultures and setting out on adventures will provide a week to remember for years to come. We will have guest chefs, guest readers, drumming performance, culinary experiences, costume making and exploration of various parts of the world! Children can also look forward to a trip to the Family Fun Center, where we incorporate math skills and get to view new parts of the city via bus.

#### Week #7 Music and Movement - 8/12/19 - 8/16/19

It's show time! Children will create a talent show, where they can display all the skills they learned this week! Children will be exposed to different dance styles, musical instruments, and even make some of their own. Children can practice their new skills at our various locations around Seattle, such as the Ballard Locks, Alki Beach, and Northgate Park.

#### Week #8 Theater and Games - 8/19/19 - 8/23/19

We have a special guest visiting 2 days this week, who will teach the children how to put on a puppet show using a projector, hand drawn puppets, scenery, and voice acting. Children will also use tools, technology, math and science in creating their performances or music video for everyone to experience.
